Message from the Mayor

New Fireworks Restrictions

The City of Hailey has two restrictions on fireworks within Hailey Municipal Code, for the peace and safety of our community. We want everyone to have fun and be safe this summer.

1. Aerial fireworks are NOT allowed at any time.
2. Nonaerial Common Fireworks may be used only during the restricted time periods below:
 - A. Independence Days** - for the periods of time beginning at midnight July 1 and ending at midnight July 5;
 - B. New Years** - beginning at midnight December 30 and ending at midnight January 1.

Welcome to Hailey Sign Completed

Hailey has a welcome sign it can be proud of. Located at the south entrance to Hailey, the sign underwent a long approval process. Constituents were involved in that decision, as they were asked to indicate their sign preference on a survey last winter. A clear favorite emerged.

This sign was designed by Andy Hawley of Hawley Graphics. The sign reflects Hailey's unique character and heritage. In order to achieve "rustic elegance" the sign materials include stone, steel and trestle wood timbers.

When Can I Water?

- Even numbered addresses water on even numbered days
- Odd numbered addresses water on odd numbered days.
- Must water before 10:00 a.m. and after 6:00 p.m.

Irrigation Times Restricted in Hailey

Hailey regulates irrigation for two purposes: water conservation and water pressure stabilization. Daytime irrigation in heat and high sunlight evaporates much of the water and burns grasses and plant leaves.

Hailey's water system holds better pressure and the water storage tanks remain full when irrigation is controlled through odd/even regulations. Because a high water tank level is important for fire-fighting, Hailey enforces its irrigation restrictions which limit the allowed irrigation time periods.

- 1st Violation - Door knob hanger with the violation marked
- 2nd Violation - Written violation letter from the City of Hailey
- 3rd Violation - Water turn off at the property without notice and a \$100 fee to reinstate service.

Breaking ground on Hailey's Wastewater Treatment Plant

Citizens passed a bond in May 2014 for over \$6 million to design and construct a biosolids handling facility at Hailey's wastewater treatment plant in south Woodside. City staff spent the winter finalizing engineered plans and carefully selecting a contractor. Contractors Northwest Inc. (CNI) was awarded the bid for the project. The project broke ground on June 16th and will take about nine months to complete construction and an additional two months to disassembling the green dome, which has corroded over the years and is past its useful life.

The goal of the facility is to replace an old obsolete facility, provide one that meets current standards and is safe for City of Hailey staff, reduce operator time by improving efficiencies and provide a product that could potentially be turned into soil compost in the future.


